### Growing Season

Vintages are usually generalized as 'great' or 'challenging,' but 2010's fruit quality varied not only between appellations but between neighboring vineyards. When a clear blue sunny day was seen in the Clements region, the heart of the Lodi and Clarksburg Appellations were still under fog. This led to specific lots delivering intense flavors, whereas others were not as memorable. When this occurs, having family estate vineyards spread out between two appellations is beneficial—we have the ability to make certain the best quality winegrapes for each varietal are included in our LangeTwins wines.

### Vineyard Notes

The Moscato vineyard sits at sea level providing fertile soil with an abundance of nutrients. We continuously manage both the nutrient and water levels to ensure the winegrapes develop strong flavors.

### Winemakers Notes

Aromas and flavors of white peach, orange blossom and honeysuckle are balanced by a little sparkle giving the wine a light body and refreshing finish. It is a classic Moscato with natural sweetness and crisp acidity.
