Growing Season

Vintages are usually generalized as 'great' or 'challenging,' but 2010's fruit quality varied not only between appellations but between neighboring vineyards. When a clear blue sunny day was seen in the Clements region, the heart of the Lodi and Clarksburg Appellations were still under fog. This led to specific lots delivering intense flavors, whereas others were not as memorable. When this occurs, having family estate vineyards spread out between two appellations is beneficial—we have the ability to make certain the best quality winegrapes for each varietal are included in our LangeTwins wines.

Vineyard Notes

This is a blend of the best performing Zinfandel vineyards. The vineyard techniques are focused and precise to deliver winegrapes that have a distinct concentration of fruit flavors ideal to make a well-balanced wine.

Winemakers Notes

The 2010 Zinfandel has an aroma of bright crushed blackberry and blueberry fruit. On the palate, loads of fresh vibrant blackberries meld with notes of spice and are balanced by a touch of vanilla oak and soft tannins. It is a luscious wine!
