Growing Season

Vintages are usually generalized as 'great' or 'challenging,' but 2010's fruit quality varied not only between appellations but between neighboring vineyards. When a clear blue sunny day was seen in the Clements region, the heart of the Lodi and Clarksburg Appellations were still under fog. This led to specific lots delivering intense flavors, whereas others were not as memorable. When this occurs, having family estate vineyards spread out between two appellations is beneficial—we have the ability to make certain the best quality winegrapes for each varietal are included in our LangeTwins wines.

By working side-by-side as a family, we are able to bring together wisdom from past generations and innovations from the present to craft the most delicious unique wines.

Winemakers Notes

This deep and vibrant purple wine opens with an aroma of blackberry and blueberry fruit. As a 100% stainless steel aged wine it is no wonder why it is a big wine full of juicy baked blackberry fruit flavors. Its pure fruit intensity is a true reflection of the vineyards!
